Requirements

To qualify for this Kickstart, we require you provide the following:

- Active deployment platform that includes *one* of the following: OpenShift, Kubernetes (cloud or on-prem), anything with Docker support or Pivotal Cloud Foundry
- Access to your deployment infrastructure (a suitable proxy is often sufficient)
- Python model, dashboard, REST API, or web app ready for production with data sources accessible via the deployment platform

Get started with deployment in a set of three deliverables:



A set of scripts and other assets to implement the desired workflow. The automation plan and deployment platform determine project deliverables:

- OpenShift - S2I builder image
- Docker or Kubernetes - Dockerfile
- Pivotal Cloud Foundry - Buildpack
